OÖ Energiesparverband – driving the energy transition

The OÖ Energiesparverband (ESV) was established by the regional government as its energy agency. It drives the energy transition by promoting energy efficiency, renewable energy and innovative energy technologies. The ESV provides comprehensive services to private households, municipalities and businesses of all sizes.

Key activities include face-to-face energy advice sessions (10,000 per year), training programmes and the development and management of funding programmes on behalf of the regional government. The ESV has issued or checked over 150,000 energy performance certificates for buildings. The agency supports energy technology companies in the context of the Cleantech-Cluster (a business network). It is active in European projects and organises the World Sustainable Energy Days, an annual conference that attracts more than 600 participants from 50 countries every year.



In addition, greenhouse gas emissions from buildings were reduced by 43 % in 10 years. The region has established itself internationally as a pioneer region for energy efficiency and the development and take-up of innovative technologies.



Gross energy consumption




Share of renewable energy in different sectors


